Sturgis Public Schools is a Class B school system with approximately 3300 students. We are located in rural St. Joseph County, right on the Indiana border midway between Detroit and Chicago. Approximately 1/3 of our student population is Hispanic, emigrating to Sturgis from a rural, impoverished area called Michocan. Sturgis Public Schools is the second largest employer in the county, hiring approximately 400 people, half of whom are certified staff. 48% of our teachers have bachelors' degrees and 52% have masters' or higher, all of them are highly qualified. Industry in the city and surrounding area is either manufacturing or farming.
