

# Mt Lebanon High School

## Public School District – Pittsburgh , Pennsylvania

The Mt. Lebanon School District serves approximately 5,300 students. Mt. Lebanon High School is the only high school in the district. The school houses a 100,000 volume library; a planetarium; science, computer and writing labs; a Fine Arts complex that includes two theaters, visual arts studios, an arts library, a professional dance studio, choral rooms, music studios, practice rooms, a full production TV studio linked to the community's cable system, applied engineering and graphics labs. Three full size gymnasiums, an indoor swimming pool, a fitness room, six tennis courts, a 7,200 seat stadium and a synthetic turf football field with synthetic running track enhance opportunities for both student and community use. The school offers a strong athletic department and student athletes compete in twenty-six interscholastic sports and consistently win championships in both boys' and girls' divisions. There are over fifty clubs and activities available to students to participate in.

Mt. Lebanon is a Pittsburgh suburb with a national reputation for excellence. Located six miles from downtown Pittsburgh, this 6.0 square mile, predominantly residential community is home to 33,000 residents. The population is highly educated and has a strong commitment to education.
