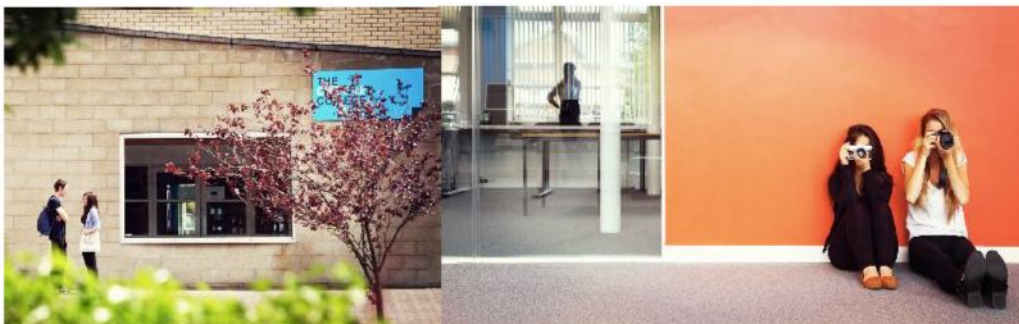
- Vocational programmes voted second best in the UK and with a 100% pass rate.
