School Profile

Hove Park offers excellent provision and has performed within the top 20% of Sixth Form Colleges nationally for the last three years. The Sixth Form is one of the city's smallest colleges and offers a personalised support package, offers work experience, volunteering opportunities and bespoke workshops.

The college has a 94% pass rate at A-Level but also has a focus on the students individual needs respective of academic or vocational ability. The community that is fostered in the school suits international students very well and they quickly settle in and start making new friends almost immediately.
